

Dog Code of Conduct

- Dog fee applies of \$50 per pet, per stay for cabins, sites have no charge
- Pet bond of \$100 applies on check in, refundable after stay, the park reserves the right to deduct amount for any damages caused by the pet
- Guests are restricted to one pet only
- Park Managers will use their discretion on how many dogs they will allow per reservation
- Service animals are permitted the property reserves the right to ask for proof
- Bookings for dogs MUST be booked in advanced to determine availability in the park
- All bookings for dogs MUST be booked via phone
- Highway1 Holiday & Lifestyle Resort will request details of the dog and reserves the right to ask for proof of registration, vaccinations, etc
- Park Managers reserves the right to sight all dogs on arrival and will use their discretion to make final decision upon arrival
- Aspen Holidays Highway 1 is governed by the Dangerous Dog Act 1995. Dangerous or aggressive dogs are not permitted at the park
- Dog owners will be required to sign a waiver for their dogs to stay in the park
- Dogs must be always on a leash or in a cage, when not inside accommodation
- Aspen Holidays Highway 1 does not have a dog off leash area located within the park.
 Designated dog areas are located outside the park or in the park next door, these areas have their own rules which need to be adhered to
- Dogs must not be exercised within the park area
- Aspen Holidays Highway 1 does not allow dog runs to be erected at any sites or cabins within the park
- Dogs must always be supervised and not left unattended, this includes being left inside a tent,
 caravan, or cabin or tied to site when owners are not onsite at the park
- It is the responsibility of the dog owner to manage their dog's behaviour
- Dog owners are personally responsible for any injuries and/or property damage losses caused by actions relating to their dog
- Dog owners are responsible for collection and disposal of their dog's waste. Please be aware
 this MUST be contained in plastic bags and disposed of in waste bins. Dog waste bags are
 located within the park » Dogs are not permitted to enter common areas, including pool areas,
 camp kitchens and laundries, due to health and safety reasons
- · Dog washing is not permitted
- Any washing of pet items is to be washed in the designated pet washing machine only
- Park Management reserves the right to ask guests to leave if any of the above is not adhered to
 or if the dog is deemed to be destructive, disruptive to other guests, noisy or aggressive in any
 way
